REGULATION OF PROGRAMMED ACTIVITIES - Post-Graduation Program in Social Policy

Considering articles 18th §3rd e 19th §3rd from Resolution # 299/2013 (Post-Graduation Program in Social Policy Regiment), the Collegiate from Catholic University of Pelotas Post-Graduation Program in Social Policy (PPGPS) establishes the following regulation for fulfillment of credits in Programmed Activities:

1. Programmed activities refer to internship in research, scientific productions or technical activities performed since the student's entry in PPGPS, being submitted by the student to the Course Collegiate for evaluation.
2. Fulfillment of credits will happen according to the following table, in the proportion of 100 (a hundred) points to 1 (one) credit, and the conversion of points in credits is allowed only for numbers multiples of 100 (a hundred).
3. Situations not foreseen in this regulation shall be examined by the PPGPS Collegiate.

SCIENTIFIC PRODUCTIONS (maximum of 400 points)	- Translation of scientific article.	Up to 10 points per work.

	- Complete work published on a national or international event.	Up to 30 points per work.
	- Book.	Up to 150 points per book.
	- Book chapter.	Up to 100 points per chapter.

	- Article published on an indexed journal, Qualis A1 or A2*.	150 points per article.
	Article published on an indexed journal, Qualis B1-B3*.	100 points per article.
	Article published on an indexed journal, Qualis B4-B5*.	80 points per article.
	- Article Qualis C or non-indexed*.	Up to 50 points per article.
TECHNICAL ACTIVITIES (maximum of 100 points)	- Participation as a listener in qualification boards or boards of examiners for PPGPS doctorate thesis or master's dissertation final defense.	10 points per defense.
	- Participation in the organization of events in the PPGPS scope.	Up to 40 points per event.
	- Participation, as a student representative, of PPGPS Collegiate or UCPEL Post-Graduation Council <i>stricto sensu</i> .	30 points for a 1-year term.
	- Oral communication or poster in an event.	Up to 10 points per event.
	- Participation in extension project coordinated by a PPGPS teacher, upon presentation of (a) activities report; (b) proof of attendance; (c) attestation from a PPGPS teacher.	Up to 25 points per semester of participation.
	- Reports elaboration, participation on commissions and other technical works requested by PPGPS.	Up to 20 points per activity.
	- Participation, as a listener, of activities (lectures, seminars and the like) organized in the scope of PPG - Research Groups and Cores.	Up to 5 points per activity.
